ELECTIVES

Electives available to PGY1 residents in the FCS year include: Cardiology, Endocrinology, Gastroenterology, Infectious Disease, Medical Oncology, Nephrology, Pulmonary Disease, Rheumatology.
 Electives available to PGY2, PGY3, and PGY4 residents include: Pediatrics, Sports Medicine, Musculoskeletal, EMG, Injection Procedures, Radiology, Amputation (Limb Salvage), Brain Injury, Spinal Cord Injury, Neurology.
 Neurology electives rotations will be at Site 3: Texas Health Resources/Harris Methodist Hospital Fort Worth.

NOTES

- Residents will fulfill their Neurology and Spinal Cord Injury education/experiences during inpatient and outpatient rotations/clinics throughout training, including elective rotations.
- Residents will fulfill their Geriatric Rehabilitation education/experiences during rotations at Texas Rehabilitation Hospital of Fort Worth, Texas Rehabilitation Hospital of Arlington, Stoll Neurodiagnostics, and the Centre for Neuro Skills - Dallas.
- General Orthopaedics (ORTHO) rotations may also include outpatient experiences under the supervision of attending physicians in orthopaedic surgery.
- OB/GYN and FM experiences will occur during the following rotations: IM, EM, WOC, DIG HEALTH, SURG, RHEUM.
- Per ACGME requirements, CON rotations do not count as inpatient or outpatient time.
- Per ACGME requirements, blocks that are purely research are labeled as such and are not associated with a participating site. Thus, research rotations are not counted in the number of rotation months per PGY level.
- Per ACGME requirements, blocks that are electives are labeled as such and are not associated with a participating site. Thus, elective rotations are not counted in the number of rotation months per PGY level.

VACATION

Residents are given 20 days of vacation per academic year. Vacation should not be more than 2 weeks at a time.
